If you have a Kindle, we can streamline the way you send books to your device. (It's easy to change this preference later.)

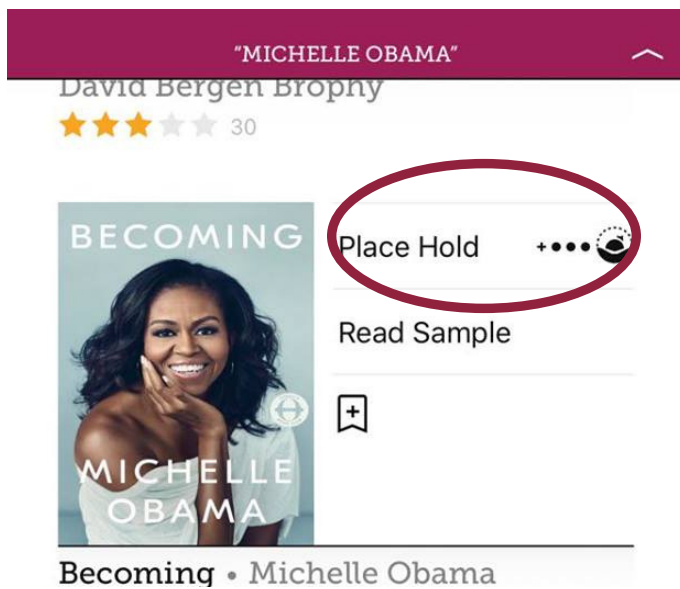
After you've found something you want to check out, simply click the "Borrow" button and confirm check out and your book will download in the app.

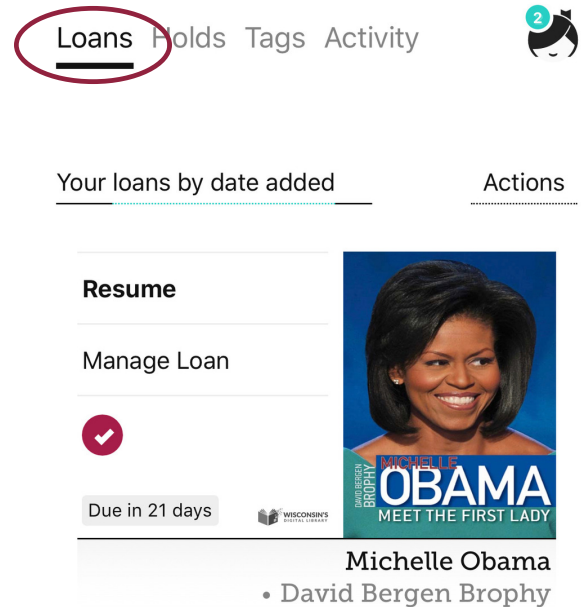
# USING LIBBY IS EASY!



Books you have borrowed appear on your bookshelf in your loans. You can read or listen easily in the app. Whether you read a few pages at a time or devour your books in one sitting, your books are easy to fine.



When you place a book on hold you can check the status of that hold. You can also curate lists using the tags feature.



If a book you want is unavailable, place a hold on it! By clicking the place hold button you will be added to a waitlist. The best part? When your book is available, it will automatically download into your loans.
